LOCAL RULES

All boundary fences and including areas marked by black pegs with white tops (right hand of the First fairway and right side of Second fairway including the tank) are out of bounds. The out of bounds marked by pegs are joined by a direct line peg to peg.

Preferred lies: A ball lying on a defined fairway may be lifted without penalty and cleaned. Before lifting the ball the player must mark its position. Having lifted the ball, it must be placed on a spot within 30cm (12 inches) of, and not nearer the hole, than where it originally lay, that is not in a hazard and not on a putting green, not within one club length of a boundary fence, out of bounds markers or an unstaked tree.

A player may place their ball only once, and it is in play once it is placed (Rule 20-4). If the ball fails to come to rest on the spot on which it is placed, Rule 20-3d applies. If the ball when placed comes to rest on the spot on which it is placed and subsequently moves, there is no penalty and the ball must be played where as it lies, unless the provision of any other rule applies.

If the player fails to mark the position of the ball before lifting it or moves the ball in any other manner, such as rolling it with a club, they incur a penalty of one stroke.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE

Match Play-Loss of hole

Stroke Play-Two strokes

*If a player incurs a general penalty for breach of local rules, no additional penalty under the local rule is applied.

- 1 The relevant Match Committee may change the use of preferred lies at any time.
- 2 If the ball strikes an overhead power line (not the post) the ball must be played without penalty.
- 3 A ball lying on top of a bridge may be lifted and dropped without penalty behind the bridge no nearer the hole.
- 4 A free drop may be taken from any formed roadway or cart path, to the nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole (except in a hazard).
- 5 A free drop is to be taken if a ball is on or within a moat surrounding a tree.
- 6 A free drop may be taken if the player's ball is resting on an embedded rock or damage to their club is likely.
- 7 A free drop may be taken if a ball is in the washed out area of the 1st Fairway

Present: Messres. Scott, Marshe, McCutcheon, Lawson, James, d'Apice, Sweetnam, Sullivan, Kinkead and McPherson. Mr. Scott was voted to the chair. It was decided to form a club to be called the **Cobar Golf Club**.

The subscription was fixed as follows:-Gentleman 10s6d (\$1.05) and ladies 2s 6d (25cents).

It was decided to supply all members with a copy of the rules. On the suggestion of Mr. d'Apice it was decided to allow residents out of the districts to be proposed to be an honorary member for one month.

It was decided to have the rules printed and distributed. It was agreed to send a letter of thanks to Mr. D. M. Campbell for his donation, with others, of nine golf tins.

The following officers were then elected:-

Vice-Presidents - Messrs, Dickson and McCutcheon.

Hon Secretary - Mr. Lawson

Committee - Messrs. D'Apice, Campbell, Scott, Marshe, Solling and Dr. Letcher.
